## From Our President

Spring is in the air, the flowers are blooming, and we (finally) are experiencing some beautiful weather. The rebirth of the flowers and trees reminds us of the Lenten season of hope and renewal. We can re-

joice in knowing that Jesus Christ died for us.

HTLC is also going through a season of hope and renewal as we welcome Pastor Kristin Hoyer as our spiritual leader. Her arrival brings an energy of excitement for the great things to come in our future. We are working to revitalize many of the programs that paused during COVID. And we

are working to stabilize the financial condition of the church.

Financial struggles are not new for HTLC. We are blessed that the congregation has always responded to pleas for help. I am hopeful that this time will be no different. Our current situation is that our regular monthly givings do not cover our standard monthly expenses. We operate at a deficit every month. But we also have several large projects that are necessary to keep the church functioning, with the most important being a new HVAC unit in the Fellowship Hall that will cost approximately \$15,000.

I love Holy Trinity. My family joined after searching

for a church where our children could learn about God and where we also felt welcome. Matt's first phone call with Nancy Fox told us that HTLC was the church for us.



The children's programs, the music programs, the inclusivity, the lack of judgment, and the love of God shone through in that conversation. We never turned back and have enjoyed every moment of our time worshipping, volunteering, and serving in Christ.

I love the people of Holy Trinity. I love the spiritual message of Holy Trinity. I feel closer to God when I step into Holy Trinity. I

feel our good work making a difference in the lives of so many in our congregation and in our greater community. This work, this spiritual work, cannot happen without your help. #### PASTOR'S REPORT

- Pastor Kristin suggested May 7 for her installation. •
- The Dean of the Conference will be here and we will have . a guest minister to speak. Other clergy will be invited.

#### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Financial Update We continue to be short on cash. Offerings every week continue to fall short of expenses and needs. We discussed sending a letter to the congregation asking for increased donations to give stability to our finances.
- Treasurer Position Vacancy We need both a Treasurer • and a bookkeeper. If needs cannot be met by someone from the congregation we will look to outsource.

#### TEAM REPORTS

- FINANCE:
  - Grant writing: We have several volunteers who are working on a grant application for security measures at the church and preschool.
  - VANCO review: Karla McGovern is looking into our use of VANCO and if we can make improvements
- **PROPERTY:** .
  - Report sent via email highlighted our need for HVAC repair (\$13,000 for Fellowship Hall) and roof repair
  - Annual fire inspection has been done
  - Matt Shultz has been working with ADT on understanding our security system.

- **WELCOME:** Chuck Whitacre reported that the Tables of 8 • are proceeding. There will be designated events for West Virginia/Western Loudoun members and charter/longterm members.
- NOMINATING: Team has been working on recruiting . council members to be nominated at June's Congregational meeting.
- MISSION: Ann Keigher questioned whether we should try • to host a yard sale again. No determination yet..

YOUTH: Confirmation will not be May 21. Actual date still to be determined.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Property Use Agreement
  - New Rates for space rental - TBD
  - Non-Paying rentals - Not all of the oth-

er groups have been paying, but have been using our space and utilities, increasing expenses. Eight groups

use the facilities, one is significantly behind in payments. We would like to allow more groups to use the facilities. We discussed having the Fire Department refer requests for hall rental that it cannot fulfil to us.

- Documents A motion was made to approve the revised Building Use Agreement and Guidelines. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
- Matt Shultz has been working with ADT on understanding our security system.
- Security Concerns Ukrainian family visited HTLC a couple of weeks requesting money.. Other churches have been visited as well. They have been escorted away from the church and we spoke with the police. We have previously put together a list of resources for such visitors..

  - Easter Two services are planned, 8:45 and 11:00
  - Maundy Thursday, Good Friday services are planned


