Psalm 139:14 - I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; that I know very well.

In October our theme is Created to be...Authentic

We are created to be authentic, to bring our whole selves and know that we are loved by our Creator.

Matthew 5:14-16 - "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

I started to consider attending seminary and possibly becoming a pastor after working at a Lutheran Camp in Northern Minnesota where I met pastors who were real, authentic people. People who not only could preach and lead, but could sit and talk with young people about life and faith. They took time to get to know the camp staff and the children attending camp. Before meeting those pastors this had not been my experience of pastors. It was a big influence on me as being authentic is important for me.

What does it mean to be authentic? What does it mean to bring our whole selves to work, school, church, and activities? Are there places where we are more our whole selves and places where we are just parts of ourselves? Probably so for there are



CALL TO ORDER – Russell Seymour called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM **DEVOTIONS** – Sandy Phillips read from Psalm 91 for reflection and discussion. **APPROVAL OF AGEND**A – A motion was made to approve the agenda as provided. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.


